3. TRACK LOCATION

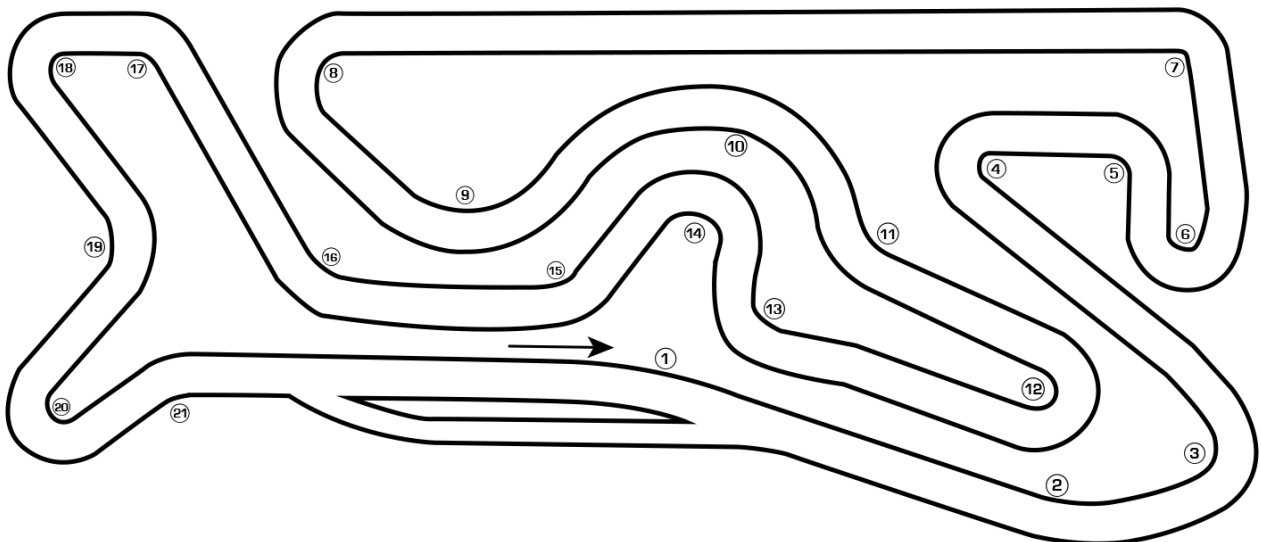
SC Performance Karting racetrack is located at 200 rue Jean-Clermont, Saint-Célestin, Québec, J0C 1G0.

4. RACETRACK DESCRIPTION

The track configuration is the one shown below.

The track has a length of 1200 meters with 21 corners. All sessions will run counter counter-clockwise.

8. REGISTRATION

Registration will open on Monday July 20th and must be done online at the link below. The standard entry fee applies from the opening of the registration until Friday July 31st at 5 PM. After this deadline, a late fee of \$25.00 + taxes will apply. At the racetrack, no device will be available for registration.

9. OFFICIAL GAS STATION

Gas used in all classes (except for Open Shifter classes) must be pump gas, grade Supreme. Gas will be controlled with appropriated tools. The spec gas for this event is the gas sold at the track (Shell V-Power – 91 octane).

10. PARKING AND PADDOCK

You must get your paddock place from SC Performance's staff before setting up your paddock. If you use a spot other than yours, you will have to move. Vehicles must park in the designated parking.

Team must send their paddock reservation to info@scperformance.ca

Opening and closing of the main gate are indicated in the event schedule. These hours will be strictly applied.

You cannot drive your kart in the paddock. Use of a kart stand is mandatory at **ALL TIME**, including during practice days.

All motorised vehicle, bicycle, scooter, skateboard are forbidden at all time **in the paddock and/or on the track**. Exception: official vehicles from the organization.

11. GARBAGE DISPOSAL

General garbage: Blue drums (many in the paddock).

Used tires: Beside the container.

12. ONSITE CAMPING

It is possible to sleep onsite from Friday July 31st until Monday morning August 3rd only. Camping space is limited, so you must register with SC Performance. Camping spots are assigned on a "first come, first serve" basis. Campers must sign and follow camping rules. Fires are not allowed and no service is provided. Send your camping request to info@scperformance.ca.

13. OFFICIAL BOARD

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, we will not have any physical official board but we will have an official virtual board. The virtual board will be a dedicated Facebook page which will be used in the same manner as we use
